- Mandatory Captain's Meeting Thursday January 22nd at 6PM – Serious Tackle
- 6. Wade fishing is permitted within sight of other team member (200 yard max).
- 7. Adult Division is per team, not to exceed 2 people MAX per team / boat. Single entries allowed..
- Fishing hours will begin at 6:30 a.m. January 24, 2026 and contestants must be in weigh-in line by 4:00 p.m. The weigh in confirmation line will open at 2:30 PM.
- You may not leave a "no-wake zone" until 6:00AM CST January 24, 2026.
- Weigh-in Slips will be handed out at the West End Marina (Sea Isle)
- 11. Artificial Bait Only
- No team is permitted to approach nearer than 50 yards to any other boat, unless permission has been granted.
- No fish may be accepted from or given to another team.
- No communication between other tournament anglers or outside sources during tournament
- 15. Boat, Wade, Kayak or PWC fishing is all permitted
- 16. Heavy Trout Stringer will win
- **17. Boundaries:** Participants may fish anywhere in West Bay, being any navigable waterway West of the Causeway Rail Bridge to SH 332 bridge.
- 18. All participants are subject to a polygraph
- 19. ALL Anglers must check in at the marina no later than 4:00 p.m. for weights to be validated.
- 20. Video Submission must be shown or previously sent to tournament director by 4PM CST.

- Your three heaviest fish will make up your total stringer.
- 24. A "side pot" trout can, if desired, be used in both the side pot & overall heavy stringer.
- 25. All Weigh master's rulings are FINAL

About the Sea Center Texas

This Texas Parks and Wildlife Department facility, Sea Center Texas, includes a marine aquarium, fish hatchery, and wetland exhibit. A 50,000-gallon aquarium allows visitors to view large Gulf of Mexico marine animals. The site's visitor center educates through interpretive displays; a 20-foot "touch tank;" and aquariums depicting native Texas habitats, including a salt marsh, jetty, reef, and open Gulf exhibits. The "touch tank" allows visitors to handle blue crabs, hermit crabs, anemones, and more. A 5-acre wetland exhibit is accessible by an elevated boardwalk.

The facility operates one of the three TPWD marine hatcheries located on the Texas coast that produce juvenile red drum and spotted speckled trout to stock in Texas bays. The hatchery has the capability to produce up to 15 million juvenile fish each year. Fish hatchery tours and educational programs are available by reservation. Admission is free to Sea Center Texas.

The Center features shark, red drum, spotted seatrout, sting rays, jack crevalle, permit, gag, scamp and rockhind groupers, oysters, clams, barnacles, periwinkle, moray eels, corals, tripletail, black drum, sheepshead, tarpon, Atlantic spadefish, stripped burrfish, jacks, lane, gray and vermillion snapper. Their wetland area features butterflies, hummingbirds, dragonflies, bulrushes, black mangroves, smooth cordgrass, wading birds, turtles, snakes, and wildflowers. A small outdoor pavilion provides a quiet resting or lunch spot adjacent to the butterfly and hummingbird gardens.
