- 5. Wade fishing is permitted within sight of other team member (200 yard max).
- Adult Division is per team, not to exceed 4 people MAX per team / boat, a guide counts as an angler.
- Fishing hours will begin at 6:30 a.m. July 12, 2025 and contestants must be in weigh-in line by 4:00 p.m. Weigh-in will begin at 2:30 p.m.
- You may not leave a "no-wake zone" or walk-in until 6:00 AM CST July 12, 2025. You can be staged at the end of no wake zone waiting for 5:30 AM.
- 9. Weigh-in @ West End Marina (Sea Isle)
- 10. Artificial, Live or Dead Bait can be used
- No team is permitted to approach nearer than 50 yards to any other boat, unless permission has been granted.
- No fish may be accepted from or given to another team.
- No communication between other tournament anglers or outside sources during tournament for purpose of fishing information. Contacting loved ones is okay.
- 14. Boat, Wade, Bank or Kayak fishing is all permitted
- 15. Heavy Stringer 5 Fish (Anglers are limited to only 3 slot reds and <u>any</u> combination of trout under 20" or flounder is acceptable to complete 5 fish stringer.

Texana Center is a member of the Texas Council of Community MHMR Services. the National Council for Behavioral Healthcare Services, and Mental Healthcare Corporations of America.
